CLIENT NEEDS:

The client wanted to reduce the amount of time team members in the field and administrative team members spent completing, transporting and handling paperwork. The company's existing forms captured critical information for complex, ongoing projects involving multiple team members and subcontractors. The client wanted to continue using these on a mobile platform without the expense and disruption of installing new backend software with mobile capabilities.

SOLUTION & IMPACTS:

iBusiness Technologies deployed MobiliForms on iPads with the MCAA Starter Pack. The MobiliForms look exactly the same as the client's original paper forms and include a Daily Log to capture work performed by field staff and subcontractors and any materials used on a job site. They also featured a Job Hazard Analysis inspection checklist, a Materials Tag and a Timesheet. The MobiliForms have embedded mathematical functionality which eliminates human error and positively impacts the client's profitability. The field and administrative team members found the transition from paper to mobile to be quick and easy since MobiliForms appear exactly as they had on paper and the intuitive iPad interface required minimal training time.
